5. Offering learners enough flexibility and control over the content.
6. Allowing easy communication between students and teachers as well as among learners themselves.

Forms a sense of learning

Following are the points through which Cross Skills forms a sense of learning -

1. Accessibility to courses inside and outside classrooms (campus- home) anytime.
2. Active communication and interaction with teachers via electronic/online methods (such as email, forums, chatting), in addition to communicating with other classmates.
3. Various learning resources (videos, recordings, graphs and pictures, and text files).

Receiving emails, announcements, notifications, or remarks from the course teacher.

Receiving online learning support via seminars (video conference) on Blackboard that is presented by the course teacher to help learners addressing issues in understanding certain parts of the course



How do we evaluate?

Assessment is done automatically, without the interference of the course teacher or with due interference of teachers. It is based on the number and frequency of learner's submissions, access, and constant interaction with different online activities such as homework, assignments and some midterms and finals. Different courses have different grades for participation and uses.
